Mistletoe and thistle

A seasonal reminder that the removal and destruction of mistletoe (*le gui*) from all poplars and fruit trees is compulsory. Also, all landowners, especially those absent for part of the year, must remove or arrange to destroy any thistle (*le chardon*) on their land before it flowers, including any in the areas along the borders.

Useful advice about your freezer – electrical current

When returning to the house after a short or long absence (especially after a holiday) we may find that the electrics were cut at some point (perhaps a digital clock is flashing?) so how do we know how long it was off before being reinstated? Did the contents of the freezer defrost and re-freeze (which is not good). To check if that has happened all you need is a cup of water and a coin. Put the cup of water in the freezer. Wait about an hour for the water to freeze, then place a coin on top of the ice and put it all back in the freezer. When you return to the freezer, if the coin is still on top of the ice, all is well. However, if it has sunk it means that the contents of the freezer were defrosted and re-frozen. It is a good idea to do this anyway, and if there was a local cut in the electricity supply you can tell how long it was off and you can be sure if the contents are safe to eat.

Something you didn't know you didn't know . . .

Recycling – each person in France has recycled the equivalent of 10kg of electrical and electronic goods in the past year as the country hit a recycling record. Recycling group *Ecosystèmes* said it took in 517,000 tonnes of electrical waste in 2016, up 12.3% on 2015 – and 2017 is already at 4.2 million items.

Festival *l'Art en liberté* in St-Fraimbault (61)

Les Grottes de Saulges – prehistoric caves

The *grottes* (caves) at *Le Roche Brault*, Thorigné-en-Charnie (53) have been closed from Nov. 2016 to March this year to avoid disturbing the bats which spend the winter there. Unique in NW France, these are natural caves, situated in the valley de l'Erve. There are 20 caves, 2 of which can be visited:- *la Grotte de Margot* and also *la Grotte de Rochefort* which offers the most interesting archaeological discoveries.
