Something for all the family – *le Roc des Harmonies*

In Granville (50) the *Pointe du Roc* is a unique experience, both educational and entertaining. The Aquarium (an aquatic world tour with sea-lions, seahorses, piranhas, angel fish, and more), Butterfly Garden (a magical, exotic world), Mineral Palace (the crystals' bright colours and varied shapes are turned into works of art) and Shell Fairyland (magnificent rooms with 3 tons of shells and coral from around the world). Snacks are available on site at the *Roc des Gourmandises*, with a wonderful view of the port and bay.

Les Chouans – local involvement

There was great unrest throughout France after the Revolution, and it was in the Laval countryside that the name *Chouan* was first applied to the royalist troops. They were led by Jean Cottereau, called Jean Chouan, who gave his name to the movement: their rallying cry was the hoot of the tawny owl (*chat-huant*). In 1793 the Whites (Royalists) occupied Laval and beneath its very walls on the low ground at *la Croix-Bataille* defeated the Republican army of General Lechelle (whose sole military precept was to march majestically and in large numbers). The Vendéen cavalry was commanded by La Trémoille, Prince of Talmont.

Some time later, La Rochejaquelein had to evacuate Laval and the Blues captured the Prince of Talmont who they guillotined at the gate of his own castle. You can find out more about this important period of French history on-line

Sun. 31st - start off your New Year celebrations with a bang! There are fireworks at the château from 19h.

Christmas Fair in Fougerolles-du-Plessis (53)

Lest We Forget : Musée de la Résistance

The Châteaubriant region (SW of Laval) also played an important part in the *Résistance* and during the liberation of France in WWII. There is a permanent exhibition in the town of Châteaubriant dedicated to the hostages and members of the *Résistance* of the area from 1940 to 1944, also photos detailing the daily life of the 600 prisoners of the Choisel internment camp. Open on Wednesdays and Saturdays 14h – 17h, free (1hr visit) with a commentary available for $3\in$. More info: *www.musee-resistance-chateaubriant.fr*

Nearby is the *Le Carrière des Fusillés*, the quarry at La Sablière (route de Laval, 44100 Châteaubriant) where on 22nd October 1941, 27 hostages were shot by the Nazis as reprisal for assassinating the German Lt-Col Holtz in Nantes.

Added alcohol immobiliser penalty for drink drivers

[With thanks to 'the Connexion', 18.11.17, for this info]: A trial that allows authorities to force drivers convicted of drink-driving to install specialised immobilisers on their vehicles is extended to a fourth *département*.

Motorists in Finistère who have been convicted of drink-driving could only be allowed back behind the wheel after serving any ban if their car is fitted with an alcohol-activated immobiliser. This is part of a trial that has already been introduced in Drôme, Marne and Nord, and will come into effect in Finistère from 1st December. If successful, it could be rolled out nationwide from 2019.
