Eating out

Over the coming months I am featuring places to go for that Special Occasion. This month:

Le Grand Cerf, 17-19 Avenue Aristide Briand, Ernée (53). Set in a former coaching house, this is a Logis 3* hotel and restaurant, run by Cedric Huard. Excellent standard, with a choice of menus - 16,20€ and 28,90€. Open every day, 11h30 to 14h & 18h30 to 22h, but closed in the evenings on Fridays and Sundays. For reservations call 02 43 05 13 09.

Brocante "Retro d'Irina"

Cheese of the Month - *Saint Marcellin*

Nowadays, *Saint Marcellin* is made from cow's milk but in the 13th century it was made exclusively from goat's milk. Originating from the Dauphine region, east of Lyon, the cheese is mild, acidic and salty. It needs a long time to mature, developing from a fresh to a dry, ripe cheese. Although quite similar to *Banon* (without the chestnut leaves) *Saint Marcellin* is even creamier and the nutty & fruity flavour is complex. Good at any time as a quick lunch, an *entrée* or on the cheeseboard. It should be chewed a long time to release its full flavour. Good wines to drink with it: (red) *Châteauneuf du Pape*, *Côtes de Ventoux*.

Walking in Normandie

There are more than 3,000kms of GR (*Grande Randonnée*) walking routes in Normandie. You can pick up a '*topo-guide*' at a Tourist Office, or visit www.normandie-tourisme.fr/avoir-a-faire.

For example: “The Circuit of the Waterfalls” in Mortain (50). Here you will find the tallest waterfalls in the west of France. This is a 7km, quite challenging walk, and you could also visit *La Petite Chapelle Saint-Michel* and *l'Abbaye Blanche* nearby. For families with children, there is an easier circuit at 3.7km.

Restored church bells in Andouillé (53)

The bells in this church were cast in Laval by M. Bunel in 1824. The larger bell (named Marie-Perrine) weighed 800kg, and the smaller bell (Jacqueline-Marie-Olympe) 326kg. They were moved to the new church in 1860. They are still in service, but urgent renovation works were necessary. Taking 15 days, the work included the addition of a striker to limit the strain on the belfry by the swinging of the bells, and the bell mechanism has been replaced by a dynamo.

Latest 'phishing' scam in France

An e-mail scam claiming to be from tax authorities is doing the rounds, officials have warned. The *Direction Générale des Finances Publiques* have warned that an e-mail inviting users to download and install a 'new version' of *impots.gouv.fr* for Windows to receive a tax refund, is a 'phishing' scam which aims to convince people to give up important personal information by fooling them into believing they are responding to an official request.

It is said that tax authorities never ask for sensitive info about a person's tax affairs by telephone or e-mail.

If you receive such an e-mail, delete it immediately. If anyone has already downloaded any files, they should inform their bank immediately to stop any fraudulent payment from going out. Victims can also file a complaint with the police. They can also alert authorities to suspected scams at the website: www.internet-signalement.gouv.fr.

Change of ownership for the bar 'Le Central' in Domfront (61)

After 13 years, Sylvie and Gerard Lambert are retiring, and the popular bar-brasserie-PMU-tabac 'Le Central' at 1 rue Maréchal-Foch (on the main junction, near the *donjon*) is now being run by 19-year old Patrick Lin.
