- ☼ Sun. 15<sup>th</sup> from 10h to 18h: the popular annual 'Garden Party', with live music and many traditional games in the gardens.
- ☼ Wed. 25<sup>th</sup>: *Promenades en calèche* (horse & buggy rides)
- ☼ on Fri. 27<sup>th</sup>: the *labyrinthe de maïs* (maize maze) opens - young and old can have fun finding their way through this maze.
- ☼ Art exhibition: there is a selection of watercolour, pastel and acrylic paintings for sale or just to admire.

### *Corso choréographique* – International Carnival in Carelles (53)

On Sun. 1<sup>st</sup> from 12h to 18h, the village of Carelles comes alive with this popular annual carnival. After the election of 'Miss Mayenne' (13h-14h15) in the presence of Miss France, the grand musical procession begins at 14h30 with many beautifully decorated floats and over 450 musicians and dancers from around the world. This event is enjoyed by around 5,000 people each year. Entry: 8€, under 14s free. ### Re-live the Middle Ages in Fougères (35)

On Sun. 22<sup>nd</sup> from 11h to 12h30 & 14h to 17h30 at the Château in Fougères, costumed men, women and horsemen will welcome you to the château and describe life in the Middle Ages. In the courtyard will be many *ateliers* (workshops), arms & an armoury, also medieval games, dances and cooking. Entry: 8,50€, children 5€. [www.ot-fougeres.fr](http://www.ot-fougeres.fr)

### *Le Jardin de la Pellerine*

For over 16 years the owners of *La Pellerine* (at La Pellerine, 53, off the RN12 between Fougères and Ernée) have nurtured the 2.5ha garden of their 17<sup>th</sup> century home. There is a succession of small intimate gardens, rich in rare plants and surprises: old-fashioned roses, unusual bushes, a 'white garden', a 'yellow garden', the '*allée des 4 saisons*', greenhouses, ponds & benches. Open for visitors again this year from May to 30<sup>th</sup> October - on Thursdays & Fridays: 10h-18h30; Sats., Suns. & fête days: 14h-18h30. Entry 7€, under 15s free.

### English guided tour of Coutances Cathedral

On Mon. 23<sup>rd</sup> at 13h30 you can have a guided tour of the high parts of the *Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Coutances* (50). Built from 1210 to 1274, this Gothic Roman Catholic cathedral stands 80 metres (295 ft) tall and dominates the town. It can be seen from as far away as Jersey. ## Route of the 105<sup>th</sup> *Tour de France*

The 7<sup>th</sup> stage of the *Tour de France* (Fougères to Chartres – 231 kms, the longest stage of the Tour) passes through the Mayenne *département* this year on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> July, including Larchamp at 12h22, St Denis de Gastines at 12h38, Chatillon-sur-Colmont at 12h51, Mayenne at 13h04, La Chapelle au Riboul at 13h30, Villaines-la-Juhel at 13h46. The first *Tour de France* was organised in 1903 by Henri Desgrange and Géo Lefèvre to help the sales of their magazine *l'Auto*. The 2018 race starts on 7<sup>th</sup> July at Noirmoutier-en-Ile (85)

### *Marchés nocturne du jeudi* (Thursday evening markets)

At the *Parc de Vaux*, Ambrières-les-Vallées (53), these are held on Thursdays in July and August from 17h to 20h.

### Visit the *Musée Charles Léandre* in the *Mairie* in Domfront (61)

On Thurs. 12<sup>th</sup> at 16h and 17h you can have a tour of a room full of interesting items - some dating from medieval times - that have been donated through the years, including paintings (Impressionist and medieval) in all mediums, and also sculptures. Free.

### Join the longest picnic table in the world!

Following on from the great success last year - when 20,000 people helped to beat the world record - on Sat. 14<sup>th</sup> is this year's *Grand Pique-Nique de la Fraternité*. From 12h to 15h you can take your picnic and join in the fun on the towpath somewhere along the 30km stretch of river between Mayenne and Laval. You pay 5€ for a metre of tablecloth and enjoy your picnic in this lovely riverside setting. Reservation info available at the Laval Tourist Office (for contact details see page 6).

### Discover the megalith '*la Table du Diable*'

On Mon. 2<sup>nd</sup> (and all Mondays in summer) you can discover this 'long-barrow' megalith near Passais-la-Conception (61). With traces of occupation of the territory by an ancient people, these megaliths are numerous in the *bocage* and the covered *allée* of the *Table du Diable* is one of the finest. At 15h30 there is a presentation of the site by a guide from the Domfront Tourist Office. Reservation required in advance (contact details page 6)..

### *Fête champêtre* in Neuilly-le-Vendin (53)

On Sun. 1<sup>st</sup> from 8h to 18h at 36 rue Normandie, at this country fair will be a *vide-greniers*, an exhibition of vintage tractors, chainsaw sculptures, inter-village games, and a bouncy castle for children.

Sun. 1<sup>st</sup> at 17h in *l'Eglise de la Ferrière* in La Ferrière-aux-Etangs (61): a concert by 'La Lyre' de Flers. Free, with donations gratefully accepted.

Sun. 1<sup>st</sup> at 17h in *l'Eglise du Sacre-Coeur* in Bagnoles-de-l'Orne (61): a classical concert by Natalie Ermacova (cello) and Eric Blin (accordion). Free, donations gratefully accepted.

Fri. 13<sup>th</sup> by the *plan d'eau des Cardamines* in Ernée (53): a concert by *l'Harmonie Municipale* and fireworks from 21h30. Free.

Fri. 13<sup>th</sup> & Sat. 14<sup>th</sup> at the Parc de la Colmont in Gorron (53): from 20h to 04h: music from several groups. On Fri. 13<sup>th</sup> at 23h will be fireworks.

Fri. 13<sup>th</sup> & Sat. 14<sup>th</sup> at Lassay-les-Châteaux (53): 'Les Entrelacés' – a street art festival in the heart of this small town. ### 'Tain-Tam Arts' concerts in Mortain (50)

### Entertainment on market day in Sourdeval (50)

On some Tuesdays in July, from 10h30 to 12h30 in Place Charles de Gaulle (*centre-ville*) there is free musical entertainment while you shop! 📅 Tues. 24<sup>th</sup>: *l'Eléfanfare* (percussion); 📅 Tues. 31<sup>st</sup>: *Le Choeur des marins de Cotentin*.

### Sunday open air concerts in Bagnoles de l'Orne (61)

As part of the festival 'les Clefs de Bagnoles' there are open air concerts on Sundays in July and August at 17h. On Sun. 8<sup>th</sup> in the Square de Contades: Dom Ferrer (vintage folk songs). Free. For details of other Sunday concerts, ask at the Bagnoles de l'Orne Tourist Office.

### Fête du Poiré in Mantilly (61)

### Entertainment at the market in Louvigné-du-Désert (35)

### Weekly *flâneries/brocante* in Bagnoles de l'Orne (61)

On every Tuesday in July and August, this *brocante* is held in *Place du Marché, Quartier Château*; around 30 stalls are expected.

### New *caserne des pompiers* (fire station) in Fougères (35)

The new fire station was inaugurated at the end of May. Covering 3,356 sq.m, it is fully adapted for modern use. Built on the site of the old fire-station, it took 3 years to build at a cost of 7.2 million euros, using 23 mainly local trades. Taking pride of place in the new garage is the famous '*planche des pompiers*' – this was created in 1895 by the Paris *sapieurs-pompiers* initially as a type of test. Sited 2.4 metres above the ground, it is a 1m x 1.3m square oak shelf, 4-5 cms thick. Each morning, the firemen had to pull themselves up on to it in full fire-fighting gear. The aim was to know that the firemen were able to depend on the strength of their arms in the case of a fall from a roof or a floor collapsing.

### Owners of the Château in Lassay-les-Châteaux meet the President

At the end of May, Aymeri and Cécilia de Montalembert, who own the Château in Lassay-les-Châteaux (53), met with the President at l'Elysée Palace, as their château is one of 250 monuments that have been chosen to benefit from help from the State via the *loto du patrimoine*. The official list of sites to benefit was made public in May, and Lassay-les-Châteaux was one of them.

### 'Pages' bookshop in Passais-la-Conception (61)

### Guided tour of Domfront Castle in English

On Wed. 18<sup>th</sup> July at 14h30 there will be a very informative and interesting 1-hour guided tour of Domfront castle, which was built 1,000 years ago. Booking is necessary (as a minimum of 3 people is required) at the Domfront Tourist Office (see page 6 for details).

This can be followed by, at 15h30, a tour of the town of Domfront – the towers, cobbled streets, timber-framed buildings – its history is still engraved on its walls. Booking necessary, as above.

### Something you didn't know you didn't know . . . .

The liqueur *Bénédictine* has always been produced at the *Palais Bénédictine* in Fécamp (76), Normandie for the entire world. It is the result of a subtle alchemy: 27 plants and spices are used to make it, and it takes around 2 years to produce the liqueur, after infusion, distillation in beaten copper stills, blendings, ageings, heating and double-distillation. Cardamon, cinnamon, clove, coriander, angelica, maidenhair, juniper, hyssop, lemon balm, myrrh, saffron & thyme are some of the plants and spices used to give *Bénédictine* its unique aspect and taste.

### *Méchoui* in Saint Aubin-fosse-Louvain (53)

On Sun. 29<sup>th</sup> there will be a lamb (or hog) roast with entertainment all afternoon. See posters for the venue.

## International Festival of folklore in Domfront (61)

On Sat. 7<sup>th</sup> at 14h30, organised by the *groupe folklorique 'Le Trou Normand'* there will be a procession through the streets of Domfront. At 21h will be a show in Ceaucé with many groups from around the world (entry payable). On Sun. 8<sup>th</sup> at 9h30 will be the procession of '*Le Trou Normand*' and all the folklore artists in costumes from around the world, from the Salle André-Rocton up to the church, followed by dances in front of the church. ## The new speed signs in place from 1<sup>st</sup> July

The very unpopular measure to reduce speed from 90 km/h to 80 km/h will take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July around France. In the Orne department alone, this applies to 5,400 km of roads and the new speed signs, which were made by a company in the Basque region, have cost the *Conseil départemental de l' Orne* the sum of 23,000€ which will later be repaid by the State.
