#### Special dates / public holidays:

- Thurs. 1<sup>st</sup> *Toussaint* (All Saints' Day) a festival honouring the saints of the Roman Catholic church. It precedes the *Fête des Morts* on the 2nd when people honour the dead and bring flowers, usually chrysanthemums and heather, to the graves of relations.
- Sun. 11<sup>th</sup> *l'Armistice* (Remembrance Day): the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of World War I. This is the day when those killed in both WWI and WW2 are remembered. Services take place across France, one of the most well known being the Memorial Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Paris.

### Eating out : 'le Saint-Léonard' in Fougères (35)

'Le Saint-Leonard' at 20 rue Nationale, Fougères (35) has been recommended as a great restaurant specialising in grills, paella, also Basque and French traditional cooking. Prettily decorated in Basque colours, it also has a room for up to 50 people, and an outside terrace with seating for up to 20. The midi menu (Tues. to Sats.) offers 3 courses for 13€ or 2 courses for 10,50€. Open: on Wed. & Suns. 12h-14h; on Tues. to Sats.: 12h-14h & 19h-22h (closed Mons.). ### Discovery walk – *Le Château du Fay*

On Tues. 6<sup>th</sup>, 15h-17h30, this 6.3km walk starts at the *quartier Belle Epoque* in Bagnoles de l'Orne (61) and passes the monument to the Rosselli brothers (who were opposed to Fascism and assassinated in 1937) and on to admire the Château du Fay – a pretty manor house from the 16<sup>th</sup> century, with its dark face of brick & granite. Reservation necessary at the Tourist Office, up to 11h30 on the day – tickets 3,50€ (under 12s free). More info at *www.bagnolesdelorne.com* 

#### Exhibition: '14-18: la Grande Guerre'

Until 30<sup>th</sup> Nov. in the *mediathèque* in Champsecret (61) is the exhibition: "*La Grande Guerre – au front et à l'arrière, 4 années de souffrances*" (The Great War (WWI) – at the Front and behind the lines, 4 years of suffering". Opening hours of the *mediathèque*: Tues & Wed.: 14h-17h30; Thurs & Fri: 16h-17h30; Sat.: 10h-12h only (closed Sun. & Mon.)

### Atelier origami

On Wed. 7<sup>th</sup>, 15h to 17h30 (and every Wednesday in November) at the *Centre Social*, 14 rue Louis Pasteur in La Ferté-Macé (61), you can learn the fascinating art of origami. Classes held in French with easy-to-follow instructions. Free. *www.lafertemace.fr* 

### Le Salon des Métiers d'Art in Granville (50)

On Sat. 3<sup>rd</sup> & Sun. 4<sup>th</sup>, this takes place in the *Salle de Herel* in Granville and it promotes artisan work with 20 professionals demonstrating their trades, old & new. Free entry, www.ville-granville.fr

#### Lions Club of Domfront - les roses de la solidarité

Traditionally in mid-November you will see members of *le Lion's Club* selling roses outside many supermarkets, commercial centres and church forecourts. They support local area events (local associations, handicapped people, families in distress, the Alzheimers Welcome Centre) as well as regional, national and international causes (including *Handi-chiens*, which trains and provides assistance dogs for handicapped people). They also organise various events – social evenings, tourist outings, flea markets, collections, exhibitions, etc.

### Something for all the family – *Biscuits du terroir*

On Thursdays  $8^{th}$  and  $22^{nd}$ , at the *Biscuiterie* in Lonlay l'Abbaye (61), where they have been making biscuits since 1909, you can discover every stage of the fabrication of these famous biscuits, which are also exported to the USA. ### Exhibition in Pontmain (53)

## Exhibition: "Bronz'Age" in Jublains (53)

Until 14<sup>th</sup> December at the *Musée Archéologique Départemental*, 13 rue de la Libération, Jublains (53) this exhibition looks at the Bronze Age and includes a bronze bracelet dating from 1,400 BC. Open daily (not Weds.), 9h30 to 17h30 but closed from 12h30 until 13h30. Entry: 4€ (free on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of each month), under 18s free.

### Monthly market in Dinard (35)

For 3 mornings a week, the *Place des Halles*, Place Rochaid, in Dinard is transformed into an open-air, top-of-the-range boutique. Cashmere sweaters, costume jewellery, perfumed candles & soaps, decorative items, designer seconds, and much more. All year round – on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

### Expo Rail Miniature de la Baie in Ducey (50)

### Feedback from October

At the new venue, the 21<sup>st</sup> *Plantes en Fête* (on 4<sup>th</sup> October in Domfront) was enjoyed by around 8,000 people. Although not such a lovely setting as the Manoir de la Guyardière, where it was held over the past 20 years, the excellent choice of flowers and vegetation covering a hectare, was still as popular as ever.

### Foire Saint-Martin in Saint-Hilaire-du-Harcouët (50)

### Change in French law

Since 18<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2018 the law has changed concerning the priority, and therefore safety, of pedestrians on road crossings. Now, if a vehicle does not stop for pedestrians on the crossings, there can be a loss of 6 points on the licence and a 135€ fine. Up to now, pedestrians had priority if they were on the crossing - but only if they gave a fair signal of their intention to cross. In France in 2017, 11,000 pedestrians were hit on crossings, 500 of them killed. Pedestrians should also be careful - if there is not a crossing within 50 metres, they are permitted to cross the road, but not diagonally, and crossing without due care and attention risks a fine of 7€.
