Exhibition: Bronzorama – a look at the Bronze Age

From 1st Feb. until 22nd April, at the *Musée Archéologique Départemental*, 13 rue de la Liberation in Jublains (53) this is a new, contemporary exhibition of the Bronze Age in the west of France (Normandy, Brittany and Pays de la Loire). Cashback of 60€ is now available

Cashback is now widely available in France and Casino supermarkets are among the first to take it up. The concept, which allows you to get cash from stores as long as you make a purchase by bank card, is already widespread in several European countries but was slow to start in France. It has come in following a European directive.

The maximum amount you can get is 60€. It is hoped this will especially help people living in rural areas, far from bank cash dispensers whose numbers have fallen in recent years.

Lest We Forget

La Petite Chapelle Saint-Michel in Mortain (50) is located on the hill of Montjoie which, at 323m, is the highest point of the town and on a clear day you can see Mont-Saint-Michel. The first chapel was built in 1613 but did not survive the Revolution; the present chapel was built in 1852 and restored in 1955. Today it is a place of remembrance of the battle in August 1944 where many soldiers lost their lives - it was held by the 2nd Battalion of the 120th Regiment of the 30th American Division 'Old Hickory' and they were surrounded for 6 days and nights by the SS, who could not take it. There is parking at the top of the hill and there is a peaceful walk along the avenue to see the memorial. www.mortain-tourisme.fr
