Eating out: 'La Carotte'

'La Carotte' is a bistro creatif at 14 Quai Carnot, Mayenne (53, on the river, below the château) serving vegetarian, bio meals with inspired menus using locally sourced ingredients. There are 'tapas' to enjoy with an aperitif, a salad bar with unusual and tasty dishes, and a menu du jour. They have a riverside terrace for sunny days, and host regular art and music events. Les Jardins des Renaudies – events in June

At these pretty gardens at Le Mézerais, near Colombiers-du-Plessis (53), created in 1988 by the *pépiniériste* Jean Renault, there are over 3,000 species of flowers, plants and trees. You can take a picnic, and there is also the *Ecomusée*, and the *Salon de Thé Anglais* which is open on Sats. & Suns. from 14h-18h. For more info: *www.jardinsdesrenaudies.fr*

Sun. 2nd: 'Rendezvous aux Jardins' with an exhibition of works by local artists, and music through the day with *l'Ecole de Musique du Bocage* and the percussion band Batucada Ambrières-les-Vallées. The theme 'Terre, Air, Feu et Eau' inspires the day.

Sat. 8th to Mon. 10th [Sun. open 10h-18h; Sat. & Mon.: 14h-18h]: *Journées Nationale* with the *Club Bonsai du Coglais*, with an exhibition and creative workshops to show the skills of Bonsai. Guided visits at 11h.

Sun. 23rd: '*Peintres aux Jardins*' (Artists in the Gardens) when artists can set up their easels around the gardens, and from 10h you can watch them paint. Judging from 17h.

Fête champêtre in La Dorée (53)

On the weekend of 15th & 16th at the *plan d'eau* (lake) in La Dorée, there will be entertainment on both days and the *vide-greniers* on the Sunday. Free entry.

Open Gardens

For the third year running, two gardens will be opening to the public at 'Les Barries', Niort-la-Fontaine (53) for the charity 'A Chacun son Everest' on Sun. 9th from 10h until 18h: a French garden of one hectare and Avis Kidd's English wildlife friendly garden, with wood sculptures. As usual, there will be a salon de thé in each garden and also plants for sale, as well as other interesting things to see. 'Les Peintres dans la rue' (Artists in the street)

On Sun. 2nd in Lassay-les-Châteaux (53) this annual competition for artists along the streets of the town, takes place from 10h to 18h. The theme is '*Un Printemps à Lassay*' (A Springtime in Lassay). Join in or watch the artists paint! There will also be a market of local products, workshops for the fabrication of musical instruments from vegetables (e.g. a flute made from a carrot!), music with *Batacuda* at 11h30 and a discovery walk around the town. 11th Fête des Plantes - 'Entre Ville et Jardin'

On the weekend of 1^{st} & 2^{nd} from 10h to 18h, this popular garden fête, organised by the *Association Entre Ville et Jardin*, is held in the grounds (*le parc-arboretum*) of the château of Bagnoles de l'Orne (61) surrounded by 154 species of magnificent trees. The theme at this festive and convivial event will be '*le parfum au jardin*' and there will be 72 stands with artisans and expo/sale of plants and garden objects. Entry $3 \in$, under 12s free. Gorron Dance Gala

♦ On Sat. 15th at 20h30 & Sun. 16th at 15h in *l'Espace Colmont*, the Gorron Dance Gala this year is 'The Wizard of Oz'. ♦ Also, Gorron Dance Orientale (Jae de Wylde and her ladies) will be dancing between 18h and 19h30 outside the Gorron *Mairie* at the *Fete de Musique* on Sat. 22nd. Feel free to go and shimmy with them! ♦ At the same time, outside the Bar des Sports, Sara from Gorron Dance will be giving demos of Modern Jazz dance with some of her girls and free taster classes for little ones.

English (VO) films in Gorron (53)

This month there will be 2 films in English in Gorron cinema. On Mon 10th: 'Avengers End Games' (sci-fi/fantasy); on Mon 24th (to celebrate the *Fête de la Musique!*): 'Rocketman', an epic musical about the incredible human story of Elton John's breakthrough years. [Note: the 'VO' film on Mon 17th ('*Douleur et Gloire'*) is in Spanish with French sub-titles]. Tickets, 5,50€, are on sale at the cinema from 20h on the night, and pre-film refreshments are available at the *Bar de la Mairie* at the bottom of the hill.

English (VO) films in Bagnoles de l'Orne (61)

For those who live a long way from Gorron, there are English language films showing in the Casino in Bagnoles de l'Orne on Monday evenings at 21h throughout the year. Note: VO [Version Original] films are in the language in which were made in (English, Spanish, German, etc.,) and are not marked as such, so are not necessarily in English, although they all have French sub-titles. Tickets are $7 \in$, (students, and each Wednesday, $6 \in$, under $14s: 4 \in$). For those wishing to have a meal beforehand, not all restaurants are open on a Monday night but the *Café de Paris* (nearby) and the pizzeria '*Il Coccodrillo*' (opposite the Casino) are open.

'Happy Independence Day'!

On the weekend of $22^{nd}/23^{rd}$ at the Hippodrome, rue de Triqueurville, in Saint-Malo (35) is a Grand Country & Western Event, one of the largest gatherings of Country & Western dancing, with 'Old West' games and also activities for the young. Lest We Forget – 75 years ago . . .

June 6th 1944 – D-Day, the largest amphibious landing in history, begins in the early-morning hours as Allied forces land on the Normandy beaches. Operation Overlord took months of planning and involved 1,527,000 soldiers in 47 Allied divisions, along with 4,400 ships and landing craft and 11,000 aircraft. By the end of the day, 150,000 Allied soldiers and their accompanying vehicles had landed and 15,000 were either killed or wounded.

Fête Annuelle de Centre Equestre

On Sun. 23rd in the *Parc des Loisirs de Vaux*, Ambrières-les-Vallées, is the fête of the Riding Centre of Ambrières-les-Vallées. There will be competitions in the morning and a horse show in the afternoon, the *vide-greniers* from 8h, pony rides & games. Free.

Rendez-vous aux Jardins – le Jardin de Clivoy (53)

On Sat. 8th (11h-18h) & Sun. 9th (14h-18h) in the gardens of the Château de Clivoy in Chailland (53) you can visit the *potager* (enclosed kitchen garden), fruit trees and roses with box-hedge surrounds, fountains, hothouses, also the English-style park − one of the prettiest sites in the Vallée de l'Ernée. Something for all the family -les *Romains dans la ville*

On Sat 8th (13h30-18h) and Sun. 9th (10h-18h) at the *Musée Archéologique Départemental*, 13 rue de la Liberation in Jublains (53) you can experience the colours and sounds of the ancient Roman town of *Noviodunum* (Jublains), with entertainment and events in the theatre and fortress. Will 'Amazon' be opening a depot near Fougères (35)?

A decision is to be made whether Amazon will open a logistics centre at Saint-Saveur-des-Landes (35, west of Fougères), which would be an ideal location between Brittany and Normandy – at present, there is no Amazon site in the north-west of France. Plans are being discussed for a 5 ha. site near the A84 *Autoroute*, which would create 80 jobs - however, nothing has been decided yet.

Fête des Jardins in Barenton (50)

'Les Guinguettes' in St-Fraimbault (61)

On Friday evenings from 23^{rd} June until 4^{th} Aug., 18h to 23h (with a short break at 20h), you can dance beside the lake on an area of 200sq.m (covered if raining) to the sound of live accordion music. Entry $6 \in$ which includes a *crêpe* and bowl of cider. No need to book – just turn up and dance the night away in this lovely setting!

'Zone bleue' parking discs

A reminder when in a town - if using a parking space within blue lines you must show your arrival time by using the official 'zone bleu disque' that can be purchased at many *Presses* (newsagents) and supermarkets. A sign nearby will show the time allowed (normally 1½ hours, but it does vary) and if no disc is visible you will be fined – or even towed away. This system does help to keep cars moving and allows more people to visit busy shopping areas.
