# Journées Européenes du Patrimoine

All over France, on the weekend of  $21^{st}$  &  $22^{nd}$  the *Journées du Patrimoine* (Heritage Days) present an opportunity to take a look behind the doors of 14,000 participating local heritage sites that are not usually open to the public. You could find yourself able to visit a private house or château, and many museums will throw open their doors for free or at a reduced price. # Something for all the family – *Fête de la Terre*

For more than 100 years, in this lovely setting, the village of Fontaine-Daniel (53) has held this fête on the first weekend of September (this year on the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>). There will be artisan stalls, artists, entertainment and games for all ages, plus swimming races in the lake. Free. There are 3 restaurants in the village – or take a picnic!

# Fête Communale in Landivy (53)

On the weekend of  $14^{th}/15^{th}$  in Landivy is the *Fête Communale*, throughout the village – a weekend of entertainment and activities. Free.

#### Lest We Forget

On Wed. 8<sup>th</sup> August was a ceremony of remembrance for the American pilots who died when their plane 'Chow Hound' was shot down by a German DCA over Lonlay l'Abbaye (61) on 8<sup>th</sup> August 1944. Sgt Treece was the radio specialist aboard the B17 bomber and was flying with the crew of 8 (3 teams of 3). They had flown 30 missions. On the site of the crash – a cornfield at the property called 'Les Vallées' - you will see an American flag flying, and at the ceremony, 9 roses were placed in memory of the 9 airmen.

#### Alzheimer's group for English speakers in the Orne.

For anyone worried about living with Alzheimer's, this group meets every 6 weeks. The next meeting date is Wed. 4<sup>th</sup>, 11h to 14h at *le Centre d'Accueil de Jour Alzheimer*, 25 rue Soeur Marie Boitier, La Ferté-Macé (61). The next event is World Alzheimer's Day – Sat. 21<sup>st</sup>, 10h to 16h, at the same venue as above. This is an open day for anyone worried about living with Alzheimer's in France. Their English representatives will be there from 10h to 16h and their French colleagues 14h to 16h.

#### Rules for picking mushrooms

The season of mushrooms is upon us, and there are over 3,000 different varieties of mushrooms in France - some of the most loved are *girolles*, *chanterelles*, *cèpes*, *bolets*, *morilles* and, of course, *les truffes* (truffles). However, there are strict rules laid down by the *Office National des Forêts*: ♦ picking must only be for family use, not for sale; ♦ for security reasons no-one must enter the area used by *la chasse*; ♦ always leave some mushroom behind (cut them so you leave some of the stem and the spores in the ground for next year); ♦ if you see a poisonous mushroom don't destroy it - nature has a purpose for it! Also, you must carry your mushrooms in a wicker basket as plastic bags ferment and damage them.

#### Miniature railway in Clécy (14)

Enter a miniature world at rue d'Emington in Clécy. Discover one of the most incredible models ever constructed in Europe, covering 310 sq.metres. Inter-active boxes to animate the models; and outside there is a train to visit the site and *fours à chaux* (lime kilns) plus a games area for children. *www.chemin-fer-miniature-clecy.com*
