### Christmas Craft Fayre in La Bigottière (53)

On Sun. 1<sup>st</sup>, 10h-16h in the *Salle des Fêtes*, rue de la Mairie in La Bigottière (53) this Christmas Craft Fayre is in support of Grande Daze Animal Companion Centre. # French people whose names are immortalised in history ... and language

This month:- Nicotine. The French penchant for tobacco is well known. It was Jean Nicot (1530-1600), the French ambassador to Portugal, who introduced tobacco to France in 1561 when he sent tobacco seeds and powdered leaves. Nicotine is derived from the flowering tobacco plant of the genus Nicotiana, named after Nicot.

### Latest 'ping call' scam – advice from the Gendarmerie

Phone calls purporting to be from *gendarmes* that ask people to call a particular number are a scam, authorities have warned. The *Gendarmerie de Nord* has issued the warning over so-called 'ping calls' which are messages intended to convince victims to call a premium rate phone line based in Mali. "If you receive a call on your fixed or mobile phone trying to sell you a particular product, or if you are asked to call back an unknown number, you are a victim of a 'ping call', warns the Northern *Gendarmerie*. "Never call back an unknown number" *gendarmes* said. If you receive an unsolicited message you can send an SMS with the one-word message 'spamvocal' to 33700 or connect to the site *https://www.33700.fr/*
