Two *marchés* in Dol-de-Bretagne (35, SW of Mont-Saint-Michel):

On Sat. 4<sup>th</sup> is the *Marché de Dol-de-Bretagne* (35) - a traditional market with local produce: cheeses, fish, flowers, artisan-made items. Open 8h30 until 13h.

On Tues. 7<sup>th</sup> is the *Marché Bio de Dol-de-Bretagne* (35) – held inside Les Halles (built in 1879), Place Chateaubriand. Open 16h until 20h30.

# 'La galette des rois' – a tasty tradition

A seasonal reminder that France celebrates Epiphany each year on the second Sunday after Christmas with the *galette des rois* – a traditional puff pastry cake filled with *frangipane*, a thick almond cream. This tradition traces its roots back to the Middle Ages when the last piece of the cake, often called the 'piece for the poor' was reserved and given to the first needy person knocking at the door. Inside is a little surprise – these days a *santon* (figurine) – and the person who gets the slice with *le santon* is declared the king and so crowned.

### Eating out: Les Potins

'Le Potins', 32 rue de Sévigné in Fougères (35, not far from the Forum de la Gare) is a brasserie / bistrot and has been recommended to me by 3 different people. It is rated 11 out of 58 restaurants in Fougères, has good food and great atmosphere with vegetarian options on the menu. Open: Mon. to Thurs. 9h30 - 14h30; Fri. & Sats. 09h30 - 22h30; closed on Sundays. Tel: 02 23 51 30 75.

### Patinoire (ice skating rink) in Saint-Malo (35)

Until Sun. 5<sup>th</sup> Jan., from 10h until midnight, daily (including New Year's Day!) the *patinoire* La Banquise is on Esplanade Saint-Vincent (by the ramparts). For the 5<sup>th</sup> year running, it will be covering 520 sq.m. Remember to take warm clothes, gloves, scarves and hats! [There is an entry cost, but it is not given on the website!].

### Exhibition of sculptures in wood

From 17<sup>th</sup> Jan. until 15<sup>th</sup> Feb., in the Salle Rousseau, Le Grand Turc, La Ferté-Macé (61), sculptor Alain Legros is holding an exhibition of his wood sculptures with the theme 'The Body'. Free entry.

### Le Bucher de Sapins – burning of Christmas trees

Organised by *les pompiers* (firemen), many villages are organising a communal burning of their used Christmas trees. In Gorron this will be on Sat. 11<sup>th</sup> at 19h30 near the old football pitch, and there will be music, snacks available and a festive atmosphere. Your *mairie* can advise you if your village/town is organising a similar event.

# Exhibition: "Fougères – a town during the Great War"

Until 28<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2020, the *Archives Municipales de Fougères* welcome the exhibition "Fougères – une ville dans la Grande Guerre: entre histoire et memoire". Historic documents describe the life of the soldiers on the front line. The Archives are open to the public on Mons., Tues., Weds., & Fridays, 13h30 to 17h30. More info at archives@fougeres.fr

## Standing stones in Fougères forest

There are remarkable standing stones in the forest of Fougères (35). The beech reigns supreme in this 1,700 hectare national forest, where you'll find an alignment of around 50 standing stones known as *Le Cordon des Druides* (the Line of the Druids). Not far away is the '*Pierre Courcoulée*', a gallery grave with an impressive cap-stone that is split in two. Also, at *les Celliers de Landéan* you will find an underground gallery of stone arches which are still very much a mystery. ## Exhibition "Grace de Monaco, princesse en Dior"

Until 5<sup>th</sup> January, at 18h in the *Musée Christian Dior*, rue d'Estouteville, Granville (50) this exhibition [which has been extended from last year due to its popularity – since its opening in April 2019 it has welcomed over 65,000 visitors] on the occasion of the 90<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the birth of Princess Grace of Monaco. The *Musée Christian Dior* highlights her personality and style – after meeting Prince Rainier III in 1955, Grace Kelly showed a particular taste for the creations of the *Maison Dior*. On display are 85 dresses of *haute couture*, and a selection of portraits, photos, film extracts, perfumes & correspondence. Entry: 12€, *reservations@museechristiandior.fr*, 02 33 61 48 21.

### New medical centre has opened in Gorron (53)

After 2 years of building work, the new *maison de santé pluridisciplinaires* is open (opposite the swimming pool). Covering an area of almost 800 sq.m it will hold 6 *médecins généralistes* (GPs), 6 *infirmières* (nurses) and one *ostéopathe* (osteopath). Two *sagesfemmes* (midwives) will be based there, and it is hoped that a *kinésithérapeute* (physiotherapist) will be there soon also.

# French people whose names are immortalised in history ... and language

This month:- Silhouette. Etienne de Silhouette was Finance Minister in the 18<sup>th</sup> century to King Louis XV, and was known for his unpopular taxes on the rich and nobility. He was notorious for his hard-line austerity and penny-pinching, so à *la Silhouette* was a term used to denote anything cheap or austere. De Silhouette's hobby of cutting shadow portraits out of paper, as a cheaper alternative to painted or sculpted portraits, was given the name *silhouette*.

## Something for all the family – le Roc des Curiosités

At the *Pointe du Roc*, 1 Blvd de Vaufleury in Granville (50) there is a unique experience, both educational and entertaining: the Aquarium (the aquatic world of Nautilus, with, seahorses, piranhas, angel fish, and more), Butterfly Garden (a magical, exotic world), Mineral Palace (the crystals' bright colours made into curious animals such as dragons and unicorns) and Shell Fairyland (magnificent rooms where over 3 tons of shells and coral from around the world are on show). Snacks are available on site at the *Roc des Gourmandises*, with a wonderful view of the port and bay from the terrace. Open all year − 1<sup>st</sup> Oct. to 31<sup>st</sup> March: 10h-12h30 & 14h-18h30; from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> Sept.: all day 10h-19h. Stamps within France will increase to 97c for a *timbre vert* and to  $\in 1.16$  for a red 'priority' stamp. International stamps, which cost the same in the EU and elsewhere as of last year, will rise from  $\in 1,30$  to  $\in 1,40$ .
