#### Special dates

W/e 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> : Les Journées du Patrimoine: All over France, on the weekend of 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> the Journées du Patrimoine (Heritage Days) present an opportunity to take a look behind the doors of over 14,000 participating local heritage sites that are not usually open to the public. You could find yourself able to visit a private house or château, and many museums will throw open their doors for free or at a reduced price. #### Treasures, Trinkets and Talent

This new shop was opened in July by Tina, a lovely English woman. It is in Le Teilleul (50) just off the main drive through the town, opposite the church, close to 'Le Royale' bar/restaurant. ## Foire d'Automne (Autumn Fair) in Gorron (53)

This popular annual *foire* is a *vide-grenier* / *braderie* and takes place throughout the town. There will be music, a funfair and entertainment. Some shops and businesses will be open for the day. [However, the road race will not take place – this has been moved to the *Foire Fleuri* in Spring 2022].

#### *Basilique de Pontmain* (53)

Sun. 19<sup>Th</sup>, as part of the *Journées du Patrimoine*, this impressive Basilica, with its fabulous stained-glass windows, will be open to visitors from 8h to 19h. #### Hot air ballooning – *Les Montgolfiades*

Fri. 10<sup>th</sup> to Sun. 12<sup>th</sup> at the Site de la Chaine, route de Montalon in St Mars-sur-Colmont (53) you can see these huge balloons in action. #### Mushroom picking – advice and rules

Here in France there are abundant quantities of wild mushrooms at this time of year – if you know where to look. There are the 'good, the bad and the ugly' and they range in size from tiny to as big as footballs. But you need to be very careful, not just when you eat them but also when you pick them. There is also a 'code of conduct' among mushroom lovers to make sure we respect the area and to try not to damage the delicate mycorrhizal roots system which will lead to new mushroom growth:

- Never pick a mushroom you do not recognise; do not destroy any you think may be dangerous they all have their part to play in nature.
- ♦ Follow the country code close gates, don't leave a mark, be quiet and respectful.
- Avoid moving dead wood around as it disturbs wildlife.
- Use a sharp knife to cut mushrooms at the base rather than rip them out of the ground as this limits damage to the mushrooms' roots and threads.
- Only collect a few from each troop leave some for others and nature. Let's learn from the cod fishing industry experiences!
- Wear bright clothing as you don't want to be mistaken for a wild animal in case the local hunters are nearby.

#### Something you didn't know you didn't know . . . .

The oldest surviving inn in France is *La Couronne* in Rouen. It was founded in 1345, and it had already been in business for 86 years when Jeanne d'Arc was burnt in the Place du Vieux Marché in 1431. It is now a popular *gastronomique* restaurant.

#### Fête Communale in Ambrières-les-Vallées (53)

At *la Ferme du Cheval de Trait* (farm of the draught horse) '*La Michaudière*' in Juvigny-sous-Andaine (61), you can watch 30 powerful horses, including a Percheron and Normand & Breton Cobs, in the fascinating hour-long show '*De la Terre à la Scène*'. #### Exhibition at the Musée Christian Dior: 'Dior en roses'

Until 31<sup>st</sup> October, this exhibition in the villa at 1 rue d'Estouteville in Granville (50) celebrates the rose, the favourite flower of Christian Dior. with models of haute couture, perfumes and accessories, but also paintings, sculptures, photos and decorative art objects.
