Special dates / public holidays

Mon. 1^{st} - *Toussaint* (All Saints' Day): a festival honouring the saints of the Roman Catholic church. It precedes the *Fête des Morts* on the 2^{nd} , when people honour the dead and bring flowers, usually chrysanthemums and heather, to the graves of relations.

Thurs. 11th - *l'Armistice* (Remembrance Day): the day when those killed in both WW1 and WW2 are remembered. Services take place across France - one of the most well-known being the Memorial Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Paris.

Eating out - Kilikia

'Kilikia' is an Armenian restaurant, at 22 Place de la République in Fougères (35). Several people have recommended it – it is clean and fresh with great staff (sisters: one cooks, the other front of house) with simple, tasty food, beautifully presented. They also do a weekly *midi* for between 9,90€ and 15,90€. An example of their dishes: Tolma with Vine Leaves (Armenian tradition with beef stuffing); Roasted quail and seasonal vegetables; Caramelised pork ribs with cane sugar and seasonal vegetables; Patatann (crusted duck leg with Madeira sauce); Dorade Royale and its garnish; Razrani Xorovac – a typical Armenian dish, Sunik region (beef with plums and baked apples). Gathering of chestnuts near Domfront (61)

On Fri. 5th from 14h30 in the Tertre Sainte-Anne (near the lower Domfront church Notre-Dame-sur-l'Eau) is "*Escapade d'automne*" - a guide will show you how and where to search on this wooded hillside for the fruits of autumn – *les chataignes*. Telephone numbers

I have been asked to repeat, for people who have newly arrived in France, the following advice. When giving your phone number, the figures should be divided into blocks of 2 (for example: 02 43 60 17 77) and it is very important to pause between the numbers to avoid ambiguity. Without the pause, 60 followed by 17 could be understood to be *soixante-dix-sept*, which is 77. So, when dictating the number 02 54 60 17 77 you would say: *zero deux* [pause] *cinquante-quatre* [pause] *soixante* [pause] *soixante-dix-sept*.

An exhibition on Celtic folklore

During November, the *mediathèque* Victor Hugo, 7 Grande Rue in in Gorron (53) will open its doors to the world of Brucéro with an exhibition entitled "*Magie Celtique*' (Celtic magic). Using watercolour, acrylic, pastels and metal impression, Breton illustrator Brucéro takes his inspiration from Arthurian legend and Breton folklore and you will see 'diverses créatures de la forêt' - sprites, elves, goblins, knights and princesses! Cheeses of the Month: Pavé d'Auge & Pavé Blésois

[Pavé is the name given to the square cobblestones you see in old French market places, and is the shape of these cheeses]

Pavé d'Auge: this Normandy cow's milk cheese, also known as Pavé de Moyaux, is a piquant cheese with a long tradition. It is a semi-soft, mild & supple, creamy cheese with a reddish rind and a relatively high fat content. Good with champagne or cider.

Pavé Blésois: made with goat's milk, this is produced in the *Blésois* region near Blois on the river Loire. Square or rectangular in shape, its rind has a dry surface covered with a silvery blue mould. The cheese is fine-textured and it tingles on the tongue. Wines to drink with it (both white): Sancerre or Pouilly Fumé

Something you didn't know you didn't know . . .
