Special dates / public holidays

Tue. 1^{st} - *Toussaint* (All Saints' Day): a festival honouring the saints of the Roman Catholic church. It precedes the *Fête des Morts* on the 2^{nd} , when people honour the dead and bring flowers, usually chrysanthemums and heather, to the graves of relations.

Fri. 11th - *l'Armistice* (Remembrance Day): the day when those killed in both WW1 and WW2 are remembered. Services take place across France – one of the most well-known being the Memorial Ceremony at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier in Paris.

Visit Vitré - 1,000 years of history

At the gateway to Brittany, take time to explore the fascinating medieval period in Vitré (35) with its castle, charming old streets and half-timbered houses. The castle – built in the 11th century then re-built in the 13th, 14th & 15th centuries – was a fortress to defend the entrance to Brittany. It is now a town hall and museum and well worth a visit.

Flour Power

In France, on packs of wheat flour you can see the letter 'T' (for type), followed by a number. The flours are classified according to their mineral content calculated on the dry matter. The higher the type, the higher the proportion of bran in the flour, and the less pure and white the flour is. This can range from the T45, ideal for pastry, to the T150 to make bran bread. Rye flour has its own codes.

Something for all the family – $le\ Zoo\ de\ Jurques$

This animal park, at *La Butte Jurques*, Dialan-sur-Chaîne (14: 20 mins SW of Caen), has over 700 animals from all over the world in 21 hectares. It is open until 6th November, then again next February onwards. You can watch the feeding of lions, red pandas, Humboldt penguins, lemurs, giraffes, vultures and polar foxes. Hockney Exhibition at the Bayeux Tapestry

This exhibition – in the David Hockney Room on the 2nd floor of the Bayeux Tapestry Museum, 13 bis rue de Nesmond, Bayeux (14) – is entitled "The Meeting of Two Legends" and is being held in Bayeux from 22/9/2022 until 23/4/2023 (closed in January 2023). The English painter is world famous and his works sell for exorbitant prices. In 2019, David Hockney fell "definitely in love with" Normandy, to the point of settling there and devoting a gigantic work to it which represents it over the seasons – with, as a backdrop, the Bayeux Tapestry (listed by UNESCO) which inspired his giant fresco "A Year in Normandy".

Cheese of the Month − Mont d'Or

This soft, round-washed cheese is from the east of France, near Switzerland. It has a distinctive woody taste because it matures in a round wooden frame and is sold in a spruce bark belt which keeps its shape and gives it a woody perfume. Featuring a beige crust, it appeals to everyone, making it a popular cheese. Available from September to May, it goes well with a dry white wine from the Jura, or a Saint-Emilion or Graves.

The specialities of Mont-Saint-Michel (50)

How can you talk about gastronomy at Mont-Saint-Michel without mentioning the famous salt-meadow lamb and the omelettes from Mère Poulard? To be tasted in the autumn or at Christmas, the salt meadow lamb first grazes for 70 days on the grassy meadows of the bay which is regularly covered by the sea. The fluffy omelettes of Mère Poulard can be enjoyed all year on the Mont.

Vélek'tro electric bikes

Along the *Côtes d'Armor* department of Brittany you can hire electric bikes. 250 bikes are available for hire at 40 rental points in the region – with a 'one-way' service that allows you to pick up the bike at one location and drop it off at another. Exhibition to discover stained-glass windows

Telephone numbers

I have been asked to repeat, for people who have newly arrived in France, the following advice. When giving your phone number, the figures should be divided into blocks of 2 (for example: 02 43 60 17 77) and it is very important to pause between the numbers to avoid ambiguity. Without the pause, 60 followed by 17 could be understood to be *soixante-dix-sept*, which is 77. So, when dictating the number 02 54 60 17 77 you would say: *zero deux* [pause] *cinquante-quatre* [pause] *soixante* [pause] *soixante-dix-sept*.
