Eoire des Rameaux in Domfront (61)

On the weekend of 1st & 2nd, the 73rd edition of this festival takes place at rue du Champ Passais in Domfront where, as well as the *vide-greniers* and 'Escape Game' on both days, there will be other activities, including a demo of cooking with *poiré* on the Sat. at 16h. A funfair, artisans, exhibition, and 2 food trucks (one with vegetarian food on the Sat.) will be on site. Entry free.

Les Jardins des Renaudies: chasse aux oeufs (Easter egg hunt)

On Sun. 9th & Mon. 10th at these pretty gardens at Les Mézerais, Colombiers-du-Plessis (53), 14h to 18h, children are invited to search for Easter pictures around the gardens, where 2,000 pictures are hidden. They are then given Easter Eggs depending on how many pictures they find! Also, all children under 12 will be given a sachet of chocolate. Something for all the family – *le base de loisirs*

This outside leisure area at La Ferté-Macé (61) has an overall area of 65 hectares – of which 26ha. is water, and also 2,400 metres of walking/cycle paths – and it is accessible all year. Dedicated to family activities in the open air, there are children's games, activities and picnic areas - ask at the Tourist Office (02 33 37 10 97) if the other seasonal facilities are available yet (kayak hire, *pétanque* pitch, pedalos, archery, swimming in the lake with a small sandy beach, etc). Access and parking is free.

Parc de la Colmont in Gorron (53)

From Sat. 9^h a new season of activities is offered in the Parc de la Colmont: tree absailing *(parcours en hauteur)*, swin-golf, paintball, laser-game, kayaking, and you can hire bikes for use in the Parc. And now for something completely different . . .

A new enterprise 'Normandie Afrah' (Afrah means Happy Festivities' in Arabic) has opened near Lonlay-l'Abbaye (61) - a 100m² showroom for the hiring of wedding outfits & accessories for European or Oriental weddings & events. At 'La Couverie', near Lonlay-l'Abbaye, Didier Pellerin, from La Ferté-Macé (61) and his Moroccan wife Nawal, have restored a farm and in the showroom are, for hire, oriental wedding thrones, handbags, jewellery, saris, veils, jewellery, furniture and table & room decorations. Nawal also offers advice and help with the organisation of weddings, soirées, birthdays and any events. Beware of toxic caterpillars – recently spotted in this area

A reminder that parents and pet owners should beware of dangerous pine processionary caterpillars (*chenilles processionnaires*) as their protective hairs contain a toxin that can cause severe skin irritation and can kill animals. In Spring, brought out by the warmer weather, the caterpillars have left the pine trees and are marching nose-to-tail across woods and open lands to find a new nest. Previously confined to the south of France, they are now to be found in the north and can cause severe damage to pine trees. Gardeners can use black sunflower seeds, sunflower hearts and suet to lure predators such as the great tit, coal tit and great spotted cuckoo which will eat hundreds of caterpillars a day. The *Mairies* have requested to be told of any sightings in your local area.

Cheese of the Month : Crottin de Chavignol

Also known as just *Chavignol*, this is probably the most famous cheese of the Loire Valley and has been produced since the 16th century in the village of Chavignol, near Sancerre. It has a natural rind which ranges from pale ivory to almost black. Made exclusively from goats' milk, it can be eaten at various stages of the maturing process – after 8 days it has a strong nutty taste, after 5 weeks it becomes dry with a richer flavour. 16 million cheeses are made annually. Great as a starter (grilled in a salad with wine vinegar) and on the cheese-board. Recommended accompanying wine: a white *Sancerre*.

Another chasse aux oeufs (Easter egg hunt)

On Sat. 8th, the Bagnoles de l'Orne (61) Tourist Office organises a *chasse aux oeufs* for children between 2 and 12 years. Starting at 10h30 in front of the château, near the fountain. Go to the *parc du château* for this colourful event. At the end you will be able to receive − chocolate! Tickets: 1€, reservation needed at the Tourist Office (02 33 37 85 66). Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Entertainment & Concerts

Sat. 15th at 20h in l'Eglise Notre-Dame de la Ferté-Macé (in La Ferté-Macé, 61): a concert by 'Veni Vidi Canto". This 12-voice choir sings *a capella* (unaccompanied) with an eclectic repertoire – traditional songs (Norwegian, Basque, Kenyan); contemporary (Queen, Radiohead). Sat. 29th at 18h at the Manoir de la Chaslerie, Domfront (61): a concert with *Le Lys de Madrigaux* (instruments & voice) with contemporary and English baroque music. A new mosaic on the *Basilique* in Pontmain

To celebrate the 150 anniversary of the building of the basilica in Pontmain (53) – which is a must-see, also for its amazing stained-glass windows – a new 3m x 3m mosaic has been installed beneath the main door archway (*le tympan*). It was created by Marie-Noël Garrigou, who began it in 2017 but sadly passed away before it was finished (two of her pupils completed it on her behalf). To make the mosaic, millions of pieces of marble and glass were used. The virgin, who has been depicted over the doorway since 1940, has had her dress and diadem re-gilded.

Emmaüs in Mayenne is to be enlarged

Re-sited in 2020 in the old Lidl premises, within a year the building proved to be too small! A large extension of 300m², an extension of 50% of the existing area, will be added on the side for crockery and bric-a-brac and also to enable more space for the sorting. The work is expected to be finished by the end of July.

La Guinguette' restaurant at Montflours is still closed

This lovely, ideally sited restaurant, on the side of the river Mayenne in Montflours (53), has been empty for the past 2 years. The two international chefs who took it over did not stay. The *Conseil départemental* is seeking a food truck to be on site for this year's tourist season, as it is very popular walkers, cyclists and horse-back riders and along the river.
