Eating out : Au Soleil d'Italie

'Au Soleil d'Italie' at 183, Les Isles, St Hilaire-du-Harcouët (50) is a pizzeria/restaurant (on the road leaving the town towards Mont-Saint-Michel). They offer several menus and a *midi ouvrier formule* (3 courses, wine/cider/soft drink included, for 14,50€) with great help-yourself buffet choices, and pizzas. Saulges prehistoric cave tours in English

On several dates in August - 8th, 10th, 17th, 21st, 24th & 28th - 11h30 to 13h, there will be two 45 min. guided tours, in English, of two of the Saulges prehistoric caves: Rochefort at 11h30 and Margot cave at 12h15. You can discover the magic and splendour of an underground world over 100,000 years old in two from more than 30 caves discovered at 650 route de la Roche-Brault, Thorigné-en-Charnie (53, SE of Laval). Artefacts found in the Margot and Rochefort caves show that man has been there for more than 25,000 years. There are stalagmites and stalagtites, a troglodyte cave and prehistoric wall paintings & engravings to wonder at. Nearby, the tranquil village of Saulges, with its 9th century church, is also worth visiting. More info at *www.grottes-de-saulges.com*

Les Jardins des Renaudies

Near Colombiers-du-Plessis (53), these lovely gardens offer a delightful wander through the gardens with pretty flowers, shrubs and trees, also a museum showing how farming life was in the 1920s & 1930s, an exhibition of art, English tea room, and the maize maze. Events in August:

Sun. $20^{\text{th}} - F\hat{e}te \ du \ miel \ et \ marché \ gourmand$ (honey festival & food market) – discover bees, their care and learn about honey extraction. There will be a produce market and *brocante* for bee-keeping items, pony rides and a concert by David Luka. Entry 5€, ages 6-16s 3€, under 6s free.

Sun. 27th, 14h-18h, **Ikebana**: floral Japanese art - discover the art of **Ikebana** Ohara, the traditional Japanese art of flower arranging. Entry: 6, 6-16s: 3, under 6s free.

Fête de la Terre in Fontaine-Daniel (53)

On the weekend of 26th & 27th, this 20th edition of the *Fête de la Terre* offers exhibitions, street entertainment, a produce market, pony rides and David Luka in concert. Free.

Les guinguettes in Saint-Fraimbault (61)

For an evening of dancing to the sound of an accordion, this popular event by the lake has been held on Friday evenings since July. The next chance will be this Fri. 4th from 18h to 23h. There are many tables, snacks & drinks available to purchase, and a specially built dance floor. A lovely venue for an enjoyable evening to the music by Jérome Ortet.

Foire aux Tissus material shop

For every need in embroidery, dressmaking, home furnishing materials, this is the place! A HUGE shop (doesn't look big from the outside) holding every possible design and colour – including, for example, several tartans and many colours of gingham (unusual to find in rural France). Very good prices – some materials are only 3€ a metre! Located just at the edge of Avranches – 90 Route de Granville, 50300 Marcy-les-Grèves. Open: Tues. to Sats.: 10h-18h (non-stop). Cheese of the Month - Saint Marcellin

Nowadays, *Saint Marcellin* is made from cow's milk but in the 13th century it was made exclusively from goat's milk. Originating from the *Dauphine* region, east of Lyon, the cheese is mild, acidic and salty. It needs a long time to mature, developing from a fresh to a dry, ripe cheese. Although quite similar to *Banon* (without the chestnut leaves) Saint Marcellin is even creamier and the nutty & fruity flavour is complex. It is good at any time as a quick lunch, an *entrée* or on the cheeseboard. It should be chewed a long time to release its full flavour. Good wines to drink with it: (red) Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Côtes de Ventoux.

Something you didn't know you didn't know . . .

... about pipistrelle bats. Pipistrelles ('pipistrello' means bat in Italian) are the smallest and most common of the 17 species of bat known to be breeding in Britain (and France hosts 34 of the 41 bat species present in Europe). Weighing no more than a 20-cent piece (3 grams) they are tiny enough with folded wings to fit into a matchbox. Despite their size, individual microbats have an enormous appetite – eating up to 3,000 insects in one night, They feed mainly on small flies, midges, mosquitos, lacewings and small moths. Rapid in flight 'with lots of twists and turns' these are the bats you are most likely to see 'aerial hawking' 2 to 20 metres above the ground after sunset.

21st Medieval weekend in Domfront (61)r

On the weekend of 5th and 6th you will find Domfront thrown back in time!! Around the town and up in the old city there will be a medieval market, a medieval banquet on Saturday evening (tickets available from the Tourist Office) and musical entertainment around the town.

At the château – for visitors to enjoy scenes of life from those times – will be tents and an encampment, with workshops for young and old. On Sunday is the tournament! On Sun. 27th, organised by *l'Association Bagnoles Moteurs Classiques:* in the morning a drive through the countryside and gathering at the aerodrome with members of the aero-club, then return to Bagnoles de l'Orne. 11h-16h: gathering at the Casino car park; at 14h30: leaving the Casino car park with a procession through the streets of Bagnoles de l'Orne. Something for all the family – *La Fosse Arthour* (61)

You can enjoy a great day out at this legendary site where King Arthur and Queen Guinevere are reputed to be buried. A lovely area and an optional gentle climb with a panoramic view from the top, and a peaceful lake and river at the bottom, where you can also enjoy a picnic. There is also a pretty Auberge by the car park where you can have a lovely lunch, or just a drink and maybe an ice cream! Look for signs to '*La Fosse Arthour*' from the village of St Georges de Rouelley (61, west of Domfront).

Day ticket at *Etang de Launay*

Anglers looking for a decent coarse fishing day ticket will be pleased to learn about the *Etang de Launay*, which is situated on the D5 route between Gorron (53) and Chatillon-sur-Colmont (53) and is easily visible from the D5. The lake contains carp to 20lbs+, tench, pike & roach, is not deep and the carp respond really well to sweetcorn fished over depth on the bottom.

The Fishery is open daily from 8h to 20h and a day ticket is $5 \in$ per rod ($4 \in$ per rod for children under 12 – who must be accompanied by an adult). A half-day ticket is $4 \in$ per rod. Tickets are available at the lakeside from the Fishery owner, who will be there several times during the day. Fishing must be by rod & line with a single barb-less hook. Spinners, lures and treble hooks are not permitted. Further information is available from the Fishery owner, Jack PetitHomme, on 06 81 69 88 22 (please note: Jack does not speak English!)
