### Eating out - May'Breizh

May'Breizh is a recently-opened restaurant and traiteur (local products supplier) at 4 rue du Prieuré in St Ellier-du-Maine (53: not on the main road but a bit off the beaten track – hopefully there are signs now to help you find it!). #### Fête du Muguet (Lily of the Valley)

On 1<sup>st</sup> May it is traditional to offer friends and family *le muguet* to bring luck and joy. This tradition was started in 1561 by King Charles IX - but some say only the sprigs which have 13 flowers bring the best luck! *Le muguet* came to France from Japan in the Middle Ages.

May 1<sup>st</sup> is the only day when people are allowed to sell *le muguet* in the streets without having the authority to operate as a business.

#### Cocktail tasting and workshop cruise

Fri. 10<sup>th</sup> from 19h to 20h30, the spirit masters of *Rhum Evasion* welcome you on board to share their cocktail science. While cruising down the river, you can taste 2 cocktails and they will then show you how to re-create them during an introductory workshop. Board the boat at the Laval river stop (near the Square de Boston) 15 minutes before departure. #### Les Jardins des Renaudies

At this lovely 3.5 ha floral park at Les Mézerais, Colombiers-du-Plessis (53), as well as 400 rhododendrons & azaleas, 350 hydrangeas, 133 varieties of roses and many other plants & flowers, there is a museum showing life on a farm in the 1920s and vintage farm equipment.

On Sun.  $5^{th}$ , 10h to 18h, will be the *Fête du Printemps* (Spring Fair) where there will be a baker baking his bread, exhibitions, local and craft market, games for young and old, at 11h a guided tour; 'Painters in the Gardens' where you can watch artists at work; pony rides, music during the day with David Luka; picnic tables; refreshment bar and Alison's Tea Room. The aim: to put producers in direct contact with consumers – and profits from the show help disabled or disadvantaged people in Mayenne. There will be over 60 winegrowers from all regions of France, with also other products: *foie gras*, honey, biscuits, cheese, oysters, cold & preserved meats. #### Cheese of the Month - Babybel

Since 2022, an established production line of Babybel was reinvested to produce a vegan cheese. Around 500 tonnes have been produced in their factory in Evron, compared with the Babybel classic of which, worldwide, 5 million are produced every day! For the vegan Babybel the main markets are the USA, Canada and the UK. Also, the company Bel is one of the 55 enterprises in France that have reduced their water consumption since 2008 - from  $30\text{m}^2$  to  $20\text{m}^2$  per tonne of cheese made, and they are aiming for  $16\text{m}^2$  in the future.
