#### Eating out - Beau Rivage

The always popular hotel/restaurant '*Le Beau Rivage*' is on the river Mayenne at the southern edge of Mayenne town (53). # *Fête du Muguet* (Lily of the Valley)

On 1<sup>st</sup> May it is traditional to offer friends and family *le muguet* to bring luck and joy. This tradition was started in 1561 by King Charles IX - but some say only the sprigs which have 13 flowers bring the best luck! *Le muguet* came to France from Japan in the Middle Ages.

May 1<sup>st</sup> is the only day when people are allowed to sell *le muguet* in the streets without having the authority to operate as a business.

#### Fête des Plantes in Bagnoles de l'Orne (61)

On 31<sup>st</sup> May and 1<sup>st</sup> June, 10h to 18h, in the Bagnoles Château parc, this is a major plant festival organised by the Association "*Entre Ville et Jardin*". There will be more than 70 exhibitors, nursery producers, craftsmen creating garden decorations, also a strolling event, a temporary garden, children's activities and prizes. This year's theme: "*jardin des pots et de bassines*" ("pots and basin gardens").

## Sewing and Craft Fayre in Vautorte (53)

This sewing and crafts fayre (*puce de couturières*) will be on Sun. 18<sup>th</sup> in the Salle de Bluets in Vautorte (53) 9h30 to 18h, organised by the association "*Atelier Couture*", and there is an optional 8km walk where you get a chance to eat local products. There is also an art exhibition with works by the local art class from Sat. 17<sup>th</sup> to Tues. 20<sup>th</sup>, 14h to 18h. For more info: 06 20 37 65 26.

#### Fishing - day ticket at *Etang de Launay*

Anglers looking for a decent coarse fishing day ticket will be pleased to learn about the *Etang de Launay*, which is situated on the D5 route between Gorron (53) and Chatillon-sur-Colmont (53) and is easily visible from the D5. The lake contains carp to 20lbs+, tench, pike & roach, is not deep and the carp respond really well to sweetcorn fished over depth on the bottom.

The fishery is open daily from 8h to 20h and a day ticket is  $5 \in$  per rod ( $4 \in$  per rod for children under 12 who must be accompanied by an adult). A half-day ticket is  $4 \in$  per rod. Tickets are available at the lakeside from the fishery owner, who will be there several times during the day. Fishing must be by rod & line with a single barb-less hook. Spinners, lures and treble hooks are not permitted. Further information is available from the fishery owner, Jack PetitHomme, on 06 81 69 88 22 (please note: Jack does not speak English!)

## Open Gardens near Lassay-les-Chateaux (61)

These gardens near Lassay-les-Châteaux – at 3, Les Baries and the adjoining garden – are open to the public to raise money for worthy causes, mainly to support sick children. On Sun.  $25^{\text{th}}$  from 10h to 18h the 2 gardens will be open for charity. Entry:  $5 \in$  for the 2 gardens. #### Annual *vide-grenier* and art exhibition

In Fougerolles du Plessis (53) the annual *vide-grenier* in the centre of the village will take place on Sun.  $18^{th}$ . [Stalls are free up to 5 metres and  $2 \in$  per metre after that. #### Cheeses of the Month - Ossau and Ossau Iraty

Made in the Béarn area (64, SW France) from raw ewes' milk, the firm-textured *Ossau* cheese comes in two kinds: plain *Ossau* or summer pasture *Ossau*, depending on what time of year it was made. To have the AOP quality label, it must be made from milk from producers practising the traditional *transhumance* of the flocks. It should not be confused with the more common Ossau-Iraty, which cannot be considered fermier (farm-made, artisanal cheese), because it comes from milk from two neighbouring areas – Ossau from Béarn and Iraty from the Pays Basque. Traditionally, both are consumed with a black cherry compote, or a chutney made of peppers and tomatoes with a touch of Espelette pepper. You can enjoy these exceptional cheeses grated and melted in a gratin or a sandwich.

# 29th International Vintage Car Tour

On Sun.  $25^{\text{th}}$  from 10h30 to 17h30, the Vintage Car Tour (150 teams from around 10 countries and 4 continents) will once again pass through Fougères and gather by the château and Place Aristide Briand – an opportunity to admire some beautiful vehicles, some of which will run on biofuel for the occasion. Made from agricultural waste, it emits 65% - 80% less CO<sub>2</sub> than fossil-based fuel. Of the 150 teams expected around half will be running on this fuel. The cars are all over 55 yeas old.

#### Organ recital

Sun. 4<sup>th</sup>, 17h to 18h15, organised by the *Les Amis de l'orgue de Sainte-Madeleine de Bagnoles de l'Orne* in the church at 9 Place de l'Eglise – a recital by Thibault Bitschené, head organist of the Cathedral of Sées. #### *Puces moto* (Motorcycle flea market)

On sale will be motorcycles, quads, equipment, helmets – everything related to motorcycles. Free entry, refreshments on site. #### Chinese restaurant in Mayenne closure

The popular Chinese restaurant 'Jardin de Mayenne' on the roundabout by the old Mayenne hospital, has closed. The huge O'Ciel Buffet restaurants in the area [one in Mayenne (next to Aldi by the hospital), one in Flers, and a newly opened one in Fougères] have resulted in a loss of clients and he could not compete. Peter and his family have run their restaurant for about 15 years and they were always welcoming. But life changes!

## *Fête de l'Abeille et de la Nature* (Festival of the Bee and Nature)

On Sat. 24<sup>th</sup>, 14h to 18h in the centre of Gorron, we celebrate Bees and all they mean to us. There will be music, games, a bee-painting *atelier* (workshop), children's make-up, pony rides and games. If you like, you can dress up in the theme of bees and nature! Free entry.

# Spotted in late April or early May – is it a damselfly or dragonfly?

There are some strong visual clues to distinguish between them. While the bodies of damselflies are slender and twig-like, dragonflies are altogether much sturdier and chunkier. In true dragonflies the eyes meet on top of the head, whereas in damselflies the eyes are separate and positioned on either side. On the wing, damselflies flit, flutter and dance: true dragonflies have a stronger, more powerful and purposeful flight. When they settle, damselflies fold their wings along their back (although those of the Emerald damselfly stick out at approx. 45 degrees) while dragonflies hold their wings at right angles to the body. The fore and hind wings of a damselfly are a similar shape and length, but in dragonflies they differ, with the hind wings being broader. So now you know!
