# Christmas lights in this area

Each year many towns and villages are specially lit up at Christmas. From now until 3<sup>rd</sup> January you can enjoy the wonderful illuminations - the main ones nearby are Mantilly, St. Mars d'Egrenne, St. Roch-sur-Egrenne, Rouellé, La Michaudière, Céaucé, Beauchêne [once voted 4<sup>th</sup> best in the whole of France!], La Sauvagère. Ask at a Tourist Office (e.g.: Domfront: 02 33 38 53 97, some English spoken) for more info, and also of a possible guided coach trip in this area.

# Foire Saint-Nicholas in Villaines-la-Juhel (53)

On Sat 6<sup>th</sup>, 9h–18h, in the Salle des Fêtes there will be many stalls selling music, linens, food, clothing, etc., with activities such a face-painting, a roller-skating horse race, a puppet show, donkey rides and funfair. (more info at *villaines-la-juhel.fr*)

There will be food on sale to the benefit of Telethon. A festive and charitable evening. A traditional parade at 18h30 with children dressed as elves will depart from Place de la Houssaie at 18h30. The food stalls will be selling hot *rillettes*, crepes, *vin chaud* (mulled wine) and hot chocolate.

## Christmas 'Open Garden'

A French lady who lives at 10 Impasse de Vieux Cimitière in Céaucé (61) is opening her garden on Sun. 7<sup>th</sup> from 10h to 18h. There will be lovely crafts and gifts for sale.
